

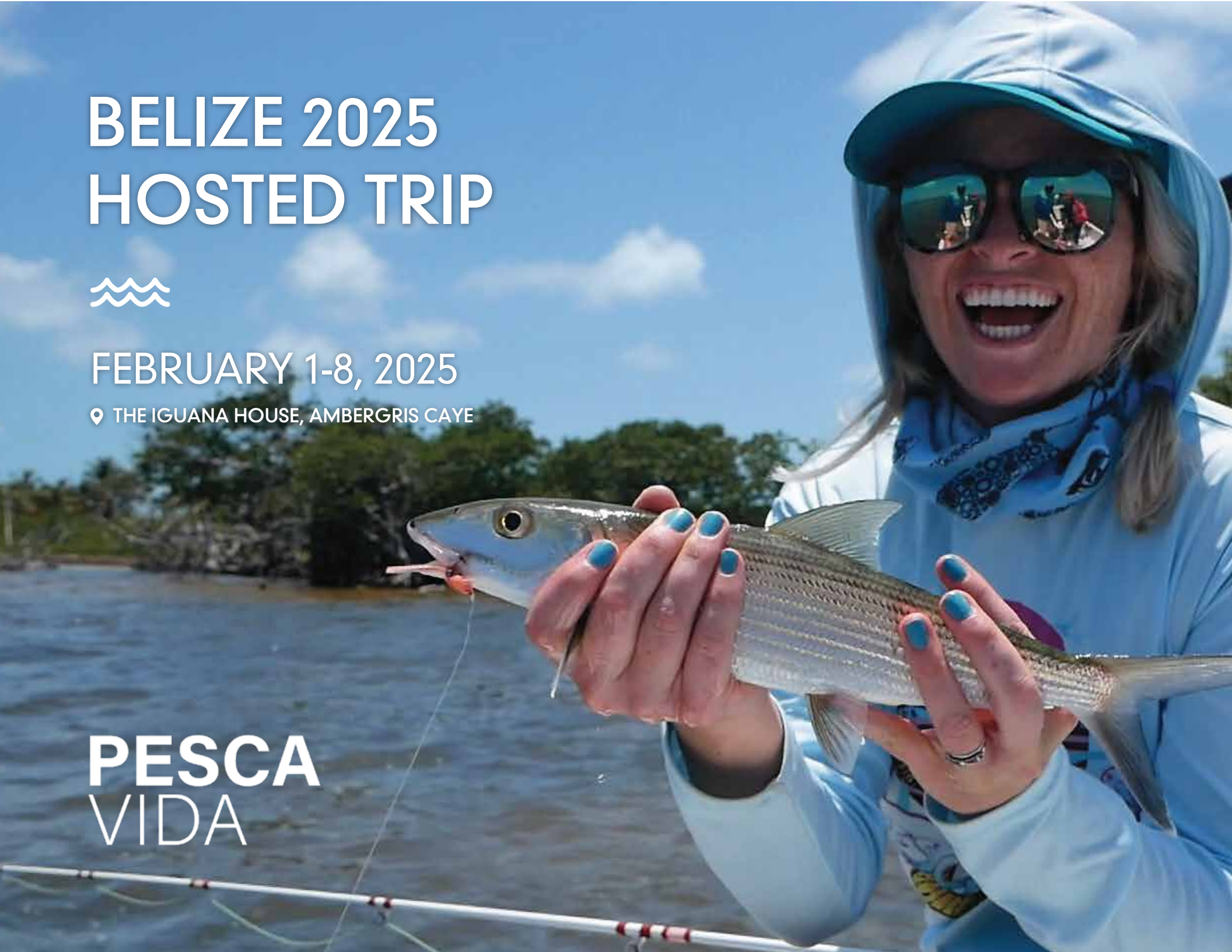

Welcome to The Iguana House, a charming retreat nestled on the picturesque Ambergris Caye in Belize.

This beautiful property offers an idyllic escape where comfort meets adventure in the heart of the Caribbean.

The Iguana House boasts spacious, well-appointed accommodations designed to provide a relaxing and memorable stay. Each room features tasteful island-inspired decor, modern amenities, and stunning views of the lush surroundings. Enjoy the cool ocean breeze from the spacious patio or unwind in the cozy living area after a day of fishing.

There are three guest quarters for anglers and explorers. Room 1 features two full beds with an adjacent bathroom. Room 2 features two full beds and an attached bathroom. Room 3 offers one queen, one full, one twin bed and an attached bathroom. **We limit our trip capacity to ensure each pair of guests enjoys the privacy and comfort of their own room.**

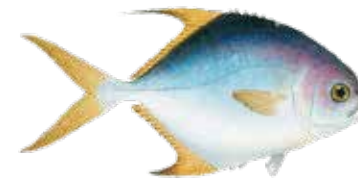
Angler Excursions

Ambergris Caye provides countless opportunities to catch the Big Three of saltwater fly fishing – Tarpon, Permit, and Bonefish.



Tarpon

Known as the "Silver King," tarpon are prized for their incredible strength and acrobatic displays. These majestic fish can grow to impressive sizes, often exceeding 100 pounds. Hooking a tarpon is a heart-pounding experience, as they are known for their explosive runs and spectacular leaps. In Belize's pristine waters, tarpon can be found in the flats, channels, and mangroves, offering anglers numerous opportunities to test their mettle.



Permit

Permit are renowned for their elusive nature and unparalleled fighting ability, making them a highly coveted catch among fly fishers. With their distinctive black tails and deep, powerful bodies, permit are often found cruising the flats in search of crabs and shrimp. Landing a permit requires precision casting, patience, and a bit of luck, as they are known to be notoriously selective feeders. Successfully catching a permit is a true badge of honor for any angler.



Bonefish

Often referred to as the "Gray Ghost" of the flats, bonefish are celebrated for their incredible speed and agility. These sleek, silver fish are masters of disguise, blending seamlessly with the sandy bottoms of the shallow flats. Bonefish are known for their blistering runs and ability to change direction in an instant, providing a thrilling and challenging experience for anglers.

Angler Excursions, continued

In addition to the Big Three, you'll also encounter a diverse array of other species, including Jack Crevalle, Barracuda, Pompano, Triggerfish, and many more. All of these species are abundant year-round, with additional migratory schools visiting the Belizean flats at varying times of the year.

We say this with confidence, you will catch fish!

Includes your stay at The Iguana House, meals, and half guided saltwater fishing and half DIY saltwater fishing for the duration of the trip.

Deposits

We offer flexible deposit options to accommodate your booking preferences for our hosted trip to Belize. You can choose from three deposit plans:

- Pay half upfront with the remaining balance due 30 days before the trip
- Pay the full amount upfront
- Opt for a \$500 non-refundable deposit with half the balance due between confirmation and 120 days before the trip and the remainder due 30 days before departure.

We accept cash, credit card, and Venmo payments. For those paying in cash, a \$500 credit card/Venmo/Paypal payment is required to secure your spot on the trip. These options ensure that your booking process is as convenient and tailored to your needs as possible.

Agenda

(Agenda is based on the mixed angler package. Fully-guided agendas and non-angler agendas are tailored by request). This agenda provides a balanced mix of guided and DIY fishing, offering structured guidance on key days while allowing for personal exploration and adventure on others. **We reserve the right to make changes to the agenda at any time. Changes may be made due to weather or unforeseen circumstances.** We aim to balance the agenda despite potential changes.

DAY 1: ARRIVAL & ORIENTATION

Anytime: Arrive at Ambergris Caye, Belize. Transfer to your accommodations and settle in. Meet your guide and fellow anglers for a welcome lunch. Overview of the week's itinerary, safety briefing, and gear check.

Evening: Relax and enjoy a welcome dinner with local cuisine. Rest and prepare for the week ahead.

DAY 2: GUIDED BOAT FISHING

Morning / Afternoon: Early breakfast around 6A, then head out on the guided panga. Guides will take anglers to the best water based on fish activity. Enjoy lunch with your guide, and fish for the afternoon. Return between 2-4PM.

Evening: Return to accommodations for happy hour and appetizers. Enjoy dinner and share stories of the day's adventures.

DAY 3: GUIDED BOAT FISHING

Morning / Afternoon: Early breakfast around 6A, then head out on the guided panga. Guides will take anglers to the best water based on fish activity. Enjoy lunch with your guide, and fish for the afternoon. Return between 2-4PM.

Evening: Return to the lodge. Dinner and an optional session on tying flies or local fishing lore.

DAY 4: DIY FISHING - OUR SECRET SPOTS

Morning: Early breakfast and scoping the docks for fish. Around 9A, load up golf carts and work our way to Secret Beach. Fish some of our secret spots along the way for bonefish and tarpon. Around 12P, enjoy lunch and relaxation at Sunset Palace or Secret Beach Bar.

Afternoon: Continue DIY fishing, options for bonefish and barracuda near Secret Beach or revisit spots on the way home. Afternoon options also include fishing the docks near Iguana house for bonefish, permit, and tarpon.

Evening: Return to accommodations. Enjoy a relaxing dinner and discuss the day's catches with fellow anglers.

DAY 5: DIY FISHING - NORTH AMBERGRIS ADVENTURE

Morning: Breakfast, then head out for a day of DIY fishing north of Iguana House. Cart ride is approximately 30 minutes to the first fishing spots. Work in teams to spot fish from the cart with ample shots at permit and bonefish. Lunch at the cart or Tranquility Bay resort.

Afternoon: Continue exploring the flats, stopping at Bacalar Chico Nature Preserve to continue on-foot through the flats.

Evening: Return to the lodge. Dinner followed by an optional cultural activity or leisure time.

Agenda, continued

DAY 6: GUIDED BOAT FISHING

Morning: Early breakfast around 6A, then head out on the guided panga. Guides will take anglers to the best water based on fish activity. Enjoy lunch with your guide, and fish for the afternoon. Return between 2-4PM.

Evening: Return to accommodations. Dinner and reflection on the day's successes and challenges.

DAY 7: GUIDED BOAT FISHING - GRAND SLAM ATTEMPT

Morning: Early breakfast around 6A, then head out on the guided panga. Guides will take anglers to the best water based on fish activity. Enjoy lunch with your guide, and fish for the afternoon. Return between 2-4PM.

Evening: Return to the lodge. Farewell dinner celebrating the week's achievements. Share photos and memories with the group, as well as awards ceremony and group photo.

DAY 8: DEPARTURE

Morning: Enjoy a final breakfast on Ambergris Caye. Check out of your accommodations and transfer to the airport for your journey home.
